At the Handheld Station, Study Buddies are used for differentiated instruction through self-paced study and cooperative learning.

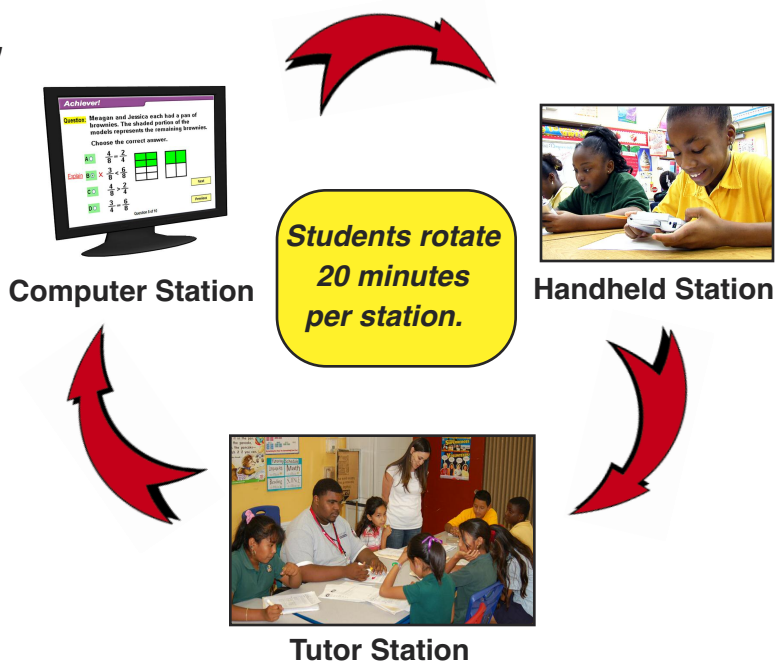
At the Tutor Station, tutors help students solve problems on worksheets.
